ENTRY FEE/ELIGIBILITY: The entry fee (\$80 OGA Member/\$100 non-member) for individual competitions and (\$160 OGA member team/\$200 non-member team) for Partner competitions includes: 18 holes of golf and prize pool. Cart rental is available on a first come first serve basis on-site for an additional fee. To register for the OGA Member rate you must be an OGA Member at the time of registration and on the date of the event.

Discounts are available as follows: **EARLY BIRD:** OGA Members registering prior to March 4th at 5:00 pm (pst) pay \$70 per entry. Mailed entries must be postmarked prior to March 4th.

METHOD OF ENTRY: The OGA Tour accepts walk-ins, phone, mail, fax and online entries. You may register via fax or through our online registration at anytime.

FORMAT: Individual tournaments are 18-hole stroke play gross and net competitions where you must hole out on every hole (NO gimmies or concessions allowed). Partner tournaments are 18-hole stroke play gross and net competition played under Rule 31 - Four-Ball Stroke Play. Each side will consist of 2 players. Each player will play their own ball throughout the round with the low gross and low net score on each hole counting toward the 18 hole gross and net score for the side. Note that the Four-Ball format requires only one player on a side to hole out on each hole though hole scores must be individually identifiable on the scorecard returned by the team.

FLIGHTS: OGA Tour events are flighted based on the handicap as of the close of entry date. The number of gross and net flights will be determined based on field size.

FIELD LIMIT: Open to the first 78 participants in the individual series and the first 40 teams in the partner series, regardless of division. Entries will be accepted according to the date and time of receipt of entry and entry fee. If the field size of an event is 15 or less the Committee reserves the right to cancel the event.

TEES: Tees are assigned by the Committee in charge of the competition, and change for each event. Typically the "Open Division" will play between 6,000-6,500 yards, and the "Senior Division" will play at 5,700-6,200 yards. Yardages are used as a guide the Committee has the right to adjust course ratings and yardages at anytime.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice rounds are not included in your entry fee. Please do not contact Private Clubs regarding practice rounds. At public and resort facilities you are welcome to contact the course directly to schedule a practice round at the going rate.

HANDICAP INDEX: The Committee reserves the right to modify a player's USGA Handicap Index. Handicap indexes will be calculated as of the close of entry date. If you wish to compete and do not have a USGA Handicap Index issued by a State/Regional Golf Association, your handicap may be reduced or refused at the sole discretion of the Committee. If you choose to participate without a handicap you will not be eligible for the net competition and will compete in "flight one" of the gross competition. If you do not have a Handicap Index issued by a State or Regional Golf Association it is recommended you contact the OGA prior to registering for more information.

COURSE HANDICAPS: The OGA utilizes Section 3-5 of the USGA Handicap System Manual to adjust course handicaps as required for players competing from different tees and genders. For Partner Series events, course handicaps are reduced according to USGA recommendations for Four-Ball Stroke Play competition - men receive 90% and women receive 95% of course handicap. In addition, if the difference between two players on the same side exceeds 8 strokes, an additional 10% reduction will be applied to both players' course handicaps.

TIES: Should the competition result in a tie for prizes the USGA scorecard method will be used to determine final position. Should a tie still remain, ties will be decided by lot. All other positions resulting in a tie will not be broken.

PRIZES AND POINTS: All prizes conform to the Rules of Amateur Status. The prize fund is determined by multiplying the number of competitors by \$20. Points are awarded based on the OGA Tour Point Schedule and top performers will be invited to participate in the OGA Tour Championship. All OGA Members with a current USGA Handicap Index are eligible to earn prizes and points. Players without a current USGA Handicap Index will only be eligible to earn prizes and points in "flight one" of the gross competition.

Optional side-games that pay both gross and net payballs will be available to participants with the option to enter the side-game upon check-in at each event. All prizes will be announced and awarded approximately 30-45 minutes after the final scorecard is received. Points will be awarded within 5-days of the competition and posted on the OGA website.

REGISTRATION/DEADLINE: All entries must be received with full payment by midnight on the deadline date. All entries are based on availability, and having your entry in by the deadline does not guarantee placement in the event.

TRANSFERS: In the event that you are unable to participate in an event you have registered for and notify the OGA prior to the registration deadline, you may transfer your entry to another OGA Tour event on a space available basis. All transfers will be charged a \$10 administrative fee.

WITHDRAWALS: If you withdraw, you must do so before the registration deadline either online or by notifying the OGA. Your entry fee will be refunded minus an administration fee of \$10 up to the registration deadline. If you withdraw for any reason after the registration deadline your entire registration fee will be forfeited.

RULES: The Rules of the USGA shall govern all play. In addition, see the OGA Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for additional Local Rules and Conditions that will be in effect during OGA Tour competitions. All players are required to check-in prior to each event where a Local Rules sheet will be distributed containing additional course specific Local Rules (check-in available until 20-mins before competition begins).

DRESS CODE: Suitable attire must be worn at all times. Suitable attire does not include spandex body wear, cutoffs, running shorts, running suits, short-shorts, tank tops, tee shirts, denim of any kind or color, or unkempt clothing of any kind. Neat and clean pants, slacks, cords, or appropriately hemmed, tailored shorts no more than six (6) inches above the knee with a minimum of three pockets are acceptable as are sweaters, sweatshirts and golf shirts with collars. Shoes must be worn at all times. Contestants failing to meet the OGA Dress Code will not be permitted to play.

STARTING TIMES/PAIRING INFORMATION: This competition is a shotgun start. All players must be at their assigned starting hole ready to play when the competition begins. Due to the short window between the registration deadline and the competition date, the OGA does not guarantee that players will receive starting hole and pairing information prior to check-in the day of the event. Check-in will open at least 60 minutes before the competition starts and closes 20 minutes prior to the competition start. The OGA Tour does not honor pairing requests and assigns starting hole and group by player or team handicaps.

PACE OF PLAY: It is your responsibility to keep pace with the group in front of you and play your round in approximately 4:30 minutes. Players are provided with a score card that shows the expected finishing time for each hole as well as the total time allotted for the round. Players/teams are expected to return their card in a reasonable time after the round (usually a maximum of 30 minutes after the expected finish time). Players/Teams deemed late by the Committee may not be eligible for prizes or points for that event. An appeals form is available to turn in with the card if extraneous circumstances warrant consideration.

LEGAL DISCLAIMER: I have noted the requirements for acceptance into this event and am qualified for the division I have entered. I understand that entries are subject to approval or rejection at any time (including during the event) by the OGA, at its discretion, and by the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. The OGA assumes no liability for any conditions of this event. Upon submitting this entry form and subsequently attending this event attendees agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the OGA and its respective affiliates directors, officers, employees, agents, and assigns from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities and losses, including, without limitation reasonable attorney's fees and costs and expenses of litigation, arising out of any negligent act or omission herein. The OGA reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The decision of the OGA in any matter shall be final.

STANDARDS OF PLAYER CONDUCT (SERIOUS MISCONDUCT): Contestants are expected to play in the spirit of the game as noted in Rule 1.2. If the Committee considers that a player is guilty of a serious breach of misconduct, including but not limited to unsportsmanlike conduct (cheating, damaging the golf course, defacing club property, using loud obscene language, throwing clubs, consuming alcoholic beverages when such consumption is prohibited by the host facility, is offensive to the contestants fellow competitors and/or causes the contestant's behavior to become offensive, etc.), penalty for serious misconduct is disqualification and possible suspension from future play in OGA Championships may be imposed. Any disciplinary actions imposed on a contestant by the OGA may be formally communicated to a representative of the contestant's club and/or to any other allied golf association that the OGA deems appropriate.

OGA NET PERFORMANCE POINTS ADJUSTMENT (KTPS): The OGA Tournament Committee has instituted a policy by which they reserve the right to adjust the Course Handicap of any competitor in future competitions. This Policy is based on a modification of the Knuth Tournament Performance Points System (KTPS) as licensed from Dean Knuth. A reduction of a competitor's Course Handicap will be based on the following criteria. High finishes in any Net portion of a 36 hole OGA championship with 81 participants or more in a division during a two year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1st=12, 2nd=10, 3rd=8, 4th=6, 5th=4. High finishes in any Net portion of a 36 hole OGA championship with 40-80 participants in a division during a two year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1st=8, 2nd=6, 3rd=4, 4th=2. High finishes in any Net portion of a 36 hole OGA championship with 20-39 participants in a division during a two year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1st=6, 2nd=4, 3rd=2. High finishes in any Net portion of a 36 hole OGA championship with 1-19 participants in a division during a two year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1st=4, 2nd=2. High finishes in any Net portion of an 18 hole OGA competition (OGA Tour - Individual Series) during a one year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1st=3, 2nd=2, 3rd=1. High finishes in any Net portion of an 18 hole OGA competition (OGA Tour - Partner Series) during a one year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1-9 teams 1st=3, 10-19 teams 1st=3, 2nd=2, and 20+ teams 1st=3, 2nd=2, 3rd=1. Any contestant who accumulates 17 points over the stated period may have their Course Handicap reduced by 1 stroke for use during the competition. Any contestant who accumulates more than 17 points during the stated period will have their Course Handicap reduced an additional 1 stroke for each additional two points accumulated.
