### ELIGIBILITY

Entrants must be the 2017 or 2018 Men's, Women's or Senior Men's Gross Club Champion of a regular OGA Member Club or qualifying Associate Club. Also eligible are 2017 & 2018 Individual Gross Champions of any Championship on the current OGA Men's, Sr. Men's, Women's Performance Points Lists, and the following performance points Leaders (Ellie Slama, Gretchen Johnson and Amanda Jacobs) as well as all past Women's Oregon Amateur Champions, 2018 Hudson Cup, 2018 Senior Hudson Cup, 2018 Morse Cup, 2018 PNGA Cup, 2018 Oregon Junior Stroke Play and Junior Amateur Champions, and the 2018 Men's Team Champions (Riverside G&CC, Mike Johansen, Dan Snoey, Todd Vrooman and Matt Hartley) and OGA Tour Championship gross champions Michael Jackson and Mitch Weisberger. Any player 50 years and older as of April 13, 2019 may compete in the Senior Division. All 2017 and 2018 Senior Club Champions must compete in the Senior Division. Course Handicaps will be determined using the April 1 Handicap Index revision. All champions must be amateurs and in good standing of an OGA Member Club. All contestants must be at least 13 years of age as of April 13, 2019.

### FIELD LIMIT

Field will be limited to the first 21 qualified women, 87 qualified men and 36 qualified senior men. Entries will be accepted according to the date of receipt of entry and entry fee.

### ENTRY FEE

\$145.00 entry fee must accompany your entry and includes three rounds of golf (one practice round and two competition rounds), an OGA hosted lunch on Saturday and tee prizes. Refunds are not available after the closing date of March 27, 2019 except for documented medical reasons. All refunds are subject to a \$20.00 administrative fee.

### ENTRY DEADLINE

Entries will be accepted according to the date of receipt of entry and entry fee. Entries must reach the OGA office by 5pm on Wednesday, March 27, 2019. Entries by telephone, FAX, or email must accompany payment. Online entries are accepted until midnight at [www.oga.org](http://www.oga.org). Late entries will be accepted and placed on an alternate's list to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the OGA Staff establishes. Late entries will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional fee of \$25. Contestants must contact the OGA in order to submit a late entry.

### FORMAT AND PRIZES

36-hole stroke play gross competition with Men's, Senior Men's and Women's Divisions. All divisions will compete from a separate set of tees. Prize awards will be made on the basis of Gross finish for the Men's and Senior Men's Division and Gross and Net finish for the Women's Division. Merchandise certificate awards will be given to top finishers. Special awards from Jones Sports Co. will be issued to the Gross Men's, Women's and Senior Men's Champions. In the event of a tie for the Men's, Women's or Senior Men's Championship, the Champion will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole playoff.

### EXEMPTIONS

Defending Champions Blake Seabaugh, Pat O'Donnell and Gretchen Johnson are exempt into the Championship. Exempt players must meet all eligibility requirements and must file an entry by the entry deadline.

### STARTING TIMES & PRACTICE ROUNDS

Starting times, pairings, and practice round information will be forwarded via email. Complete tournament information will be at [www.oga.org](http://www.oga.org).

### AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION & CADDIES

Contestants may use automotive transportation and fees must be paid by the contestant to the club at the time of rental. A maximum of two carts is allowed per group. Spectator carts are not allowed without prior approval of the committee in charge of the competition. Contestants may use a caddie.

### RULES

The Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA and The R&A govern play. The OGA Local Rules and Terms of the Competition for the 2019 OGA and OJG Championships and Events are in effect, along with additional Local Rules or Terms as provided on the applicable Notice to Players and this entry application.

### CONDITIONS & SCHEDULES

The OGA assumes no liability for any conditions of the competition. Upon submitting this entry form and subsequently playing in this competition, players agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the OGA and its respective affiliates directors, officers, employees, agents, and assigns from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities and losses, including, without limitation reasonable attorney's fees and costs and expenses of litigation, arising out of any negligent act or omission of the indemnifying party in connection with the conditions herein. The Committee in charge of the competition reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The decision of the Committee in any matter shall be final.

### INCLEMENT WEATHER

The OGA will make every effort to complete the scheduled number of rounds of the tournament. As a general policy, in circumstances under which the final round is suspended due to inclement weather and it becomes impossible to complete the round on the same day: 1) If all players in the field/flight/division have not completed at least 9 holes, the results of the Championship will be determined by reverting to the previous round's totals and the suspended round will be canceled, or 2) If all players have completed at least 9 holes of the final round, every effort will be made to finish the final round on the following day. All decisions to suspend or resume play will be at the discretion of the Committee. Any additional information regarding guidelines for suspensions and cancelations can be obtained by contacting the OGA.

### OGA NET PERFORMANCE POINTS ADJUSTMENT (KTPS)

The OGA Tournament Committee has instituted a policy by which they reserve the right to adjust the Course Handicap of any competitor in future competitions. This Policy is based on a modification of the Knuth Tournament Performance Points System (KTPS) as licensed from Dean Knuth. A reduction of a competitor's Course Handicap will be based on the following criteria: High finishes in any Net portion of a 36 hole OGA championship with 81 participants or more in a division during a two year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4. High finishes in any Net portion of a 36 hole OGA championship with 40 - 80 participants in a division during a two year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1st = 8, 2nd = 6, 3rd = 4, 4th = 2. High finishes in any Net portion of a 36 hole OGA championship with 20 - 39 participants in a division during a two year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1st = 6, 2nd = 4, 3rd = 2. High finishes in any Net portion of a 36 hole OGA championship with 1 - 19 participants in a division during a two year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1st = 4, 2nd = 2. High finishes in any Net portion of an 18 hole OGA competition (OGA Tour - Individual Series) during a one year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1st = 3, 2nd = 2, 3rd = 1. High finishes in any Net portion of an 18 hole OGA competition (OGA Tour - Partner Series) during a one year period will be awarded points accordingly: 1 - 9 teams 1st = 3, 10 - 19 teams 1st = 3, 2nd = 2, and 20+ teams 1st = 3, 2nd = 2, 3rd = 1. Any contestant who accumulates 17 points over the stated period may have their Course Handicap reduced by 1 stroke for use during the competition. Any contestant who accumulates more than 17 points during the stated period will have their Course Handicap reduced an additional 1 stroke for each additional two points accumulated.
